Microbial Soil Conditioners & Supplements

- ◆ Works on turf & landscaping
- ◆ Improves water-holding capacity of the soil
- ◆ Increases cation exchange (CEC) reactions
- ◆ Buffers salts and toxins
- ◆ Breaks up clay/caliche soils
- ◆ Retains water-soluble inorganic fertilizers
- ◆ Increases aeration of soil and improves drainage
- ◆ Promotes micronutrient uptake
- ◆ Promotes soil pathogen suppression
- ◆ Reduces other fertilizer requirements
- ◆ Reduces other fertilizer requirements

Recommended Fall Application

Apply 5 to 10 gallons to the acre (depending on soil conditions) followed by an early Spring application to maximize soil restoration, and harvest yields.
